Evangelism - God's Commandment for His People

Evangelism is the proclamation by word and deed to people of the saving act of God through Jesus Christ, with the desire that they trust Christ and become Christian disciples through the work of the church.

Eight months ago, our Pastor and the Church Council asked that a task force committee be formed to look into the future of our church. This committee known as the "Joel" Committee was taken from the Old Testament prophet who encouraged "Then, after doing all those things, I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughter will prophesy. Your old men to dream dreams and the young men to see visions." Joel 2:28 (NLT) This 14 member committee was made up from church leadership along with a representation from every age group and longevity in our church. This committee met and prayed in earnest asking God to reveal to us His will and direction for our church.

We are blessed to be a church growing in numbers as well as spiritually and we do embrace a wonderfully welcoming "personality" in our church. Along with these blessings comes the responsibility to make sure we are charting our course in the direction God desires. The Joel Committee studied eleven principles of church growth and in particular the positive growth experienced by Frazer UMC in Montgomery, Alabama, documented in the book "Tried and True". During the Joel committee discussions we dove deeply into the health of our church, the demographics of this community, the needs of the community, our church strengths and weaknesses and what seems like a simple question but one most critical, do we really desire to grow? Growth involves numbers, but more importantly, personal sanctification through the work of the Holy Spirit. Deciding to grow is the most difficult questions any church has to face. It is not an easy one and it is not answered once and for all. Growth always requires change and change is not easy. Change requires an open mind to hear and obey the voice of Christ and a willingness for all members to do their part to be successful.

The recommendation that was adopted by Church Council as a long range plan was to grow by putting our total focus on evangelism. The kind of evangelism we are describing encompasses both proclamation and presence. It is a task that belongs to all members of a congregation wherever they are at work, worship, or leisure. It has been proven that the most effective evangelism happens through the local church. This is a structure of accountability. The concept assumes that evangelism is not complete when a person joins the church, but that is a part of the process of involving that person in the life of the congregation. Evangelism includes every member of this congregation. Evangelism is not a committee in the life of the church, it is the charge of the church.

So how do we drive growth through Evangelism? The scope of the planning process centers on three areas: Ministries, Staff and Facilities. We used the analogy of the three legged stool where it takes all three legs for a stool to function. Likewise, for positive growth we will have ministries that focus on evangelism, a staff that trains and equips people for ministry; and facilities that afford staff and lay people a place to be in ministry. The three must form an equilateral triangle to be effective with each one supporting the other. Matthew 28:19-20 commands us: "Therefore, Go and Make Disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you and be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Using a focus on Evangelism, the committee made the following recommendations as goals to the Church Council. These recommendations were adopted and will be used as a guide as we move forward.

Ministries

- 1-Promote Biblical knowledge and understanding to strengthen spiritual growth of adults.
- 2-Provide an engaging and Christ-centered youth and children's ministry to support families.
- 3-Be the hands and feet of Christ outside of our church walls to reach out and touch people from all backgrounds, specifically those who are hurting and/or are in need.
- 4-Provide opportunities for church members to connect- socially & spiritually- to strengthen & deepen relationships.

Staff

- 1-Love, support and affirm our current staff.
- 2-Explore adding the following full-time/part-time staff positions to support and enhance the ministries of the church. (in order of priority)
 - a. Volunteer/Lay Person Coordinator- responsible for understanding spiritual gifts of members and plugging them into ministries, assists on nominations, provides training for ministry members.
 - b. Communications Specialist- responsible for outreach through social media, photos, website, AV assistance, media.
 - c. Youth Pastor or Director of Children's/Youth Ministries

Facilities

- 1-Contract with a professional firm to evaluate and develop a Master Plan to support future growth.

 What would future growth look like or what would a purpose-built structure to further ministry look like.
- 2-Invest resources in the Gray House to ensure structural integrity and usability for youth ministries.
- 3-Identify upgrades/renovations to existing facilities to support church ministry priorities including, but limited to, technology, lighting improvements and furnishings.

Lastly we were tasked to review and update our church vision statement to better match a focus on Evangelism. Whereas our current vision of Bring them in, build them up and Send them out has been effective, the committee recommended a vision statement that most closely defined our church and this was adopted by Church Council.

This new vision statement is a challenge to each member personally and a charge for us collectively as a congregation:

"By knowing Him, we seek to make Him known to all people through the love and grace of Jesus Christ."

Our fervent desire is that every single church member unite together to make disciples for Jesus Christ. We must say "yes!" to God, putting His goals for our church above our own desires. Will you join us in prayer, repenting of any self-promoting motives, and seeking a deeper and more focused personal relationship with Christ that results in greater personal evangelism?

"Now to Him who by the power that is working within us is able to do far beyond all that we ask or think, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." Ephesians 3:20-21
