Wednesday, February 26, 6:00 PM

Ash Wednesday is the official beginning of the season of Lent. For centuries, the church has observed this 40 day period preceding the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus as a time of repentance. It begins our journey as we focus on the reason why Jesus came into this world. He came to teach us, yes; He came to show us who God is and what he is like, yes; BUT he came into this world with the primary mission to give his life as a sacrifice for you and me. Long ago, Isaiah prophesied, in detail, that the Messiah would come and be "despised and rejected.....a man of sorrows....pierced for our transgressions....the bearer of our sins." (chapter 53)

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN RESUMES!!! February 17, 2020

On January 19, 2020, the Administrative Council of FUMCC voted to tear down the Shell house rather than attempt to renovate and bring it to "Code" not knowing what the ultimate cost of renovation might be. Based on recent bids, the costs to demolish the house, remove all debris including the oil tank plus fill-in and level the site may be up to \$21,000. We currently have \$9,145 in hand for this purpose and now know we need to collect up to \$11,855 more to complete our "Campaign". Assuming there are no "surprises", when this additional amount is collected, the Campaign will officially end and any excess funds will be returned to the donor(s) unless the donor wishes to redirect the excess contribution to the church for other use or designated purpose such as the "Organ Fund".

Thank you for your patience as final decisions are made to complete this very successful "Campaign".
